Tuscany Region





Tuscany is a region in central Italy with an area of about 23,000 square kilometers and a population of about 3.8 million inhabitants.

Regione Toscana (Tuscany Region) is the regional authority and administrative body of the region; it has legislative, administrative, and financial autonomy and is responsible, on a regional level, for issues including education, social issues, healthcare, international cooperation, and the environment.

The health system is the sector to which the region commits the largest share of its budget and organizational structure. It is, in spite of and even more so in a period of economic crisis, a driving force of development for the entire regional economy, in which economic development is seen not as an end in itself but also includes, in a context of sustainability, measures tied to the social sector and the environment.






Since 2005, Tuscany has been active with International Health Cooperation projects








